

Bexsero vaccine error warning



Additional checks are recommended due to a high number of spacing errors that have occurred.

As well as all the normal checks, we strongly recommend the use of the following to double check you have the correct spacing and schedule:

- · Confirm details including current age
- Double check past vaccine history. For PMS, check Immunisation Schedule, and All Immunisation tabs for Medtech.) On AIR, check number of MenB doses, age when given and spacing between doses.

BEXSERO VACCINATION SCHEDULES		
Age when Bexsero first dose given	Number and timing of doses	
Infants >6 weeks to <11 months	 2 doses separated by 8 weeks Plus booster dose aged ≥12 months or a minimum of 6 months after second dose, whichever is later 	
Infants ≥12 to ≤23 months (for first dose)	- 2 doses separated by 8 weeks - Plus booster dose given 12-24 months after second dose	
Children ≥24 months (for first dose) and adults*	- 2 doses separated by 8 weeks - Booster doses are funded for high-risk groups
